	 Attending to breakdowns of equipment, including, but not limited to, fillers, processing equipment, labellers, sleevers, shrink-wrap machines, etc. Problem-solving to address equipment breakdowns. Close off any corrective actions that may have been raised. Adhere to planned maintenance schedules for filling and other equipment to reduce unplanned breakdowns.
Qualifications and	One of the following is required:
Experience Required	 Qualification in dairy processing, trade tested electrician/fitter, high speed filling machinery, relevant N6 diploma or higher education, plus 3 – 4 years relevant experience; OR Minimum N4 electrical/fitter, or related, plus 8 – 10 years relevant experience.
	 Incumbent would need to have an attention to detail.
	Possible experience would include maintenance technician, filling machine technician, fitter/electrician.
	 Experience in dairy or FMCG is required. An understanding of the following areas would be necessary: Filling Machinery; Food & Beverage industry; Pneumatics; Hydraulics; Machine Electrical; Machine Mechanics; and PLCs.
	• Other skills necessary for the job include good communication, time management, problem-solving and critical thinking skills.
	 Candidates must be willing to work shifts, overtime, Public Holidays and weekends, as required.
